An Overview of the Retention Dashboard can be viewed by on campus users on the SharePoint site.

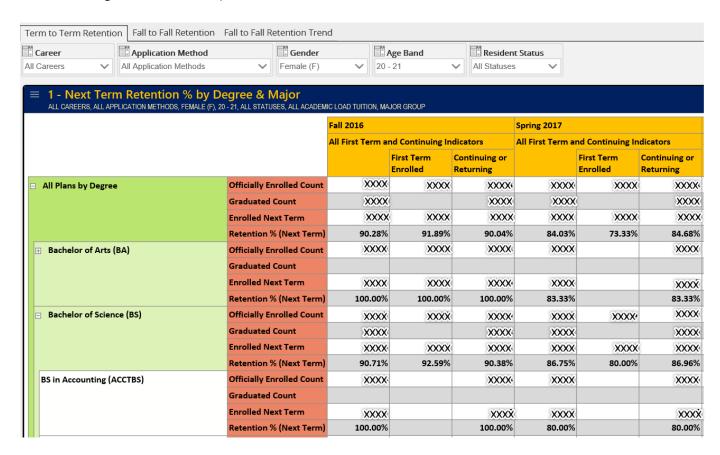
Retention Dashboard provides retention rate details in 3 slides which includes the aggregate Fall to Fall retention "trend" for 3 Fall semesters.

Data shown includes enrolled student head count, count of students who graduated (this number is excluded in retention rate calculation), enrolled students in next Term or the next Fall and the Retention Rate.

Each Report can be filtered based on Career and Application Method Filters in case of any interest to see those who applied using online application or applied thru Royall or submitted hard copy application at various fairs.

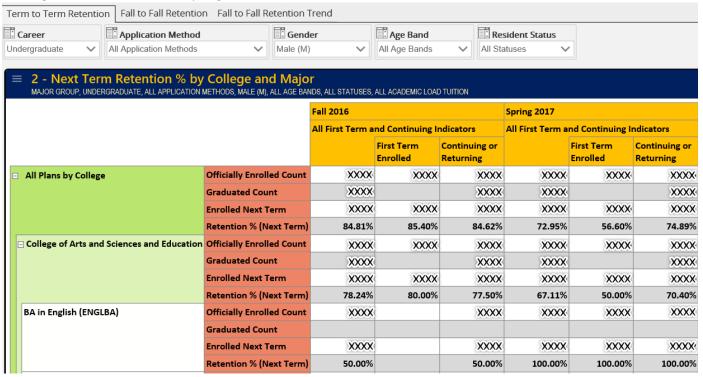
Such detailed information provides insight and points out degrees and plans with high/low retention rates so that administrators, Deans, Chairs, Advisors etc., can take corrective action.

- <u>A.</u> <u>Term to Term Retention:</u> This retention slide provides the retention rate for Students returning to next semester, which could be, Fall to Spring or Spring to Fall (Next term Retention). Retention rate is reported by:
 - 1. Retention rate by Degree type and plan within degree type (e.g. 20-21 year old female BA, BS and BS Accounting student retention)



2. Retention rate by Career, College and Plan (e.g. Undergraduate male students seeking BA in English degree within CASE Fall to Spring Retention)

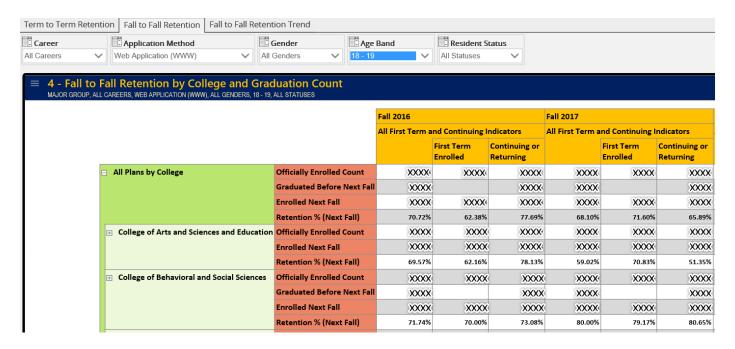


- **B.** Fall to Fall Retention: This retention slide provides retention rates for students enrolled in a given Fall semester came back for subsequent Fall semester. Fall to Fall retention can be viewed in the following 2 formats:
 - 1. Retention rate by Degree type and plan within degree type (e.g. Off-Campus graduate students seeking MS in Addiction Counseling Fall to Fall retention)



2. Retention rate by Career, College and Plan (e.g. 18-19 year old CASE and CBSS students who applied using a Web Application Fall to Fall retention)



<u>C.</u> <u>Retention Trend:</u> This slide reports Fall to Fall retention. Academic levels in each term can be expanded to see the student population by Grad/Ugrad as well as Acad Level such as Freshman, Junior, Sophomore etc.
