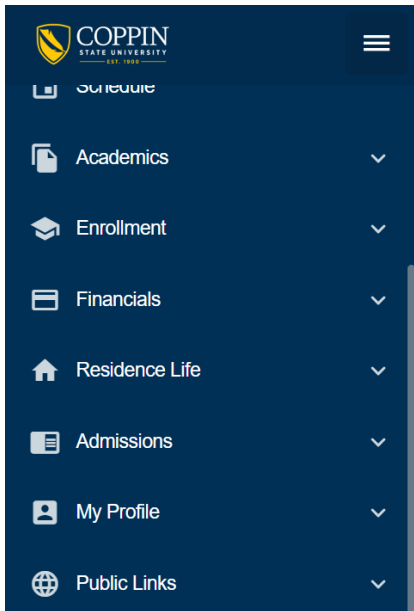


# How Do I Access My Personal Information
